

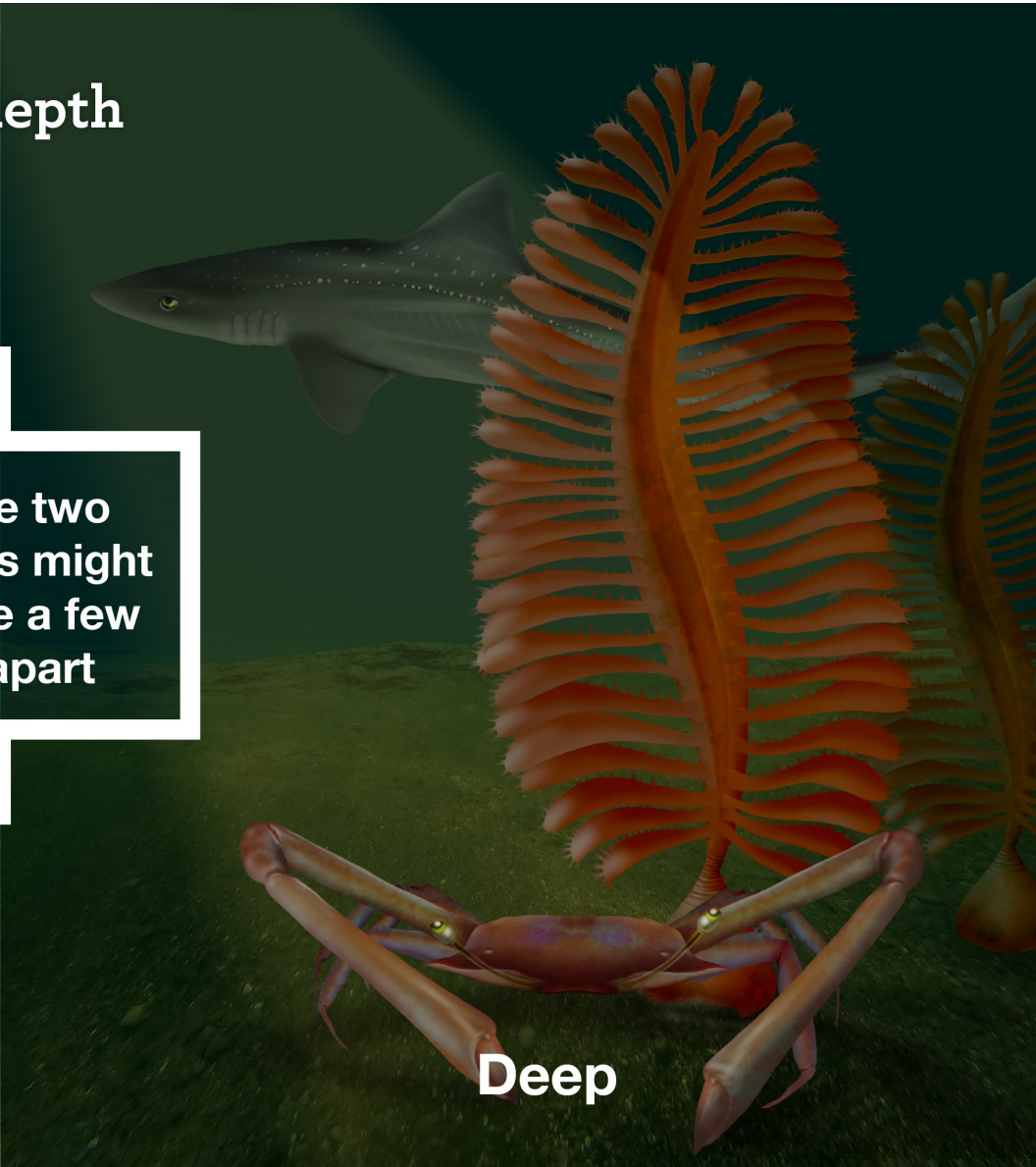
Within a region, habitats differ by depth
