
Appendix 12: Murchison Mountains Stoat traps 2019 – plus additional predator kills





Trap catch for 2017 04 May check




Results from predator trapping

The unit of measure used for how many rats and stoats being caught is Corrected Trap Nights (CTN). There was a definite peak in rat captures in 2017, similar in shape (though not as large in scale) to the peak seen in the 2012 mast year. Stoat captures were slightly higher than the year before but did not show the same peak as seen in the 2012 and 2015 stoat plague years.
