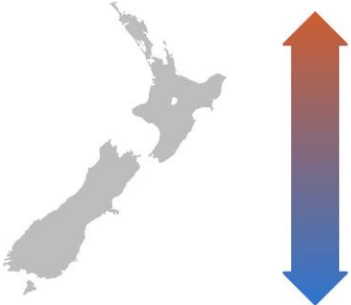


Our coastal waters are diverse

New Zealand runs north to south over 30° of latitude, from the warm subtropics to the cold subantarctics. Northern and southern rocky reefs are dramatically different due to the change in temperature.



Snapper are more abundant in the North

Blue cod are more abundant in the South

These two habitats are 100's of kms apart
