Kenya, Africa


"Water is not plentiful in Kenya. We live in an area where there is no piped water. The fresh water we need for cooking, cleaning and for our animals is carried in buckets from a local pond. If you are a lucky Kenyan, you have rainwater tanks to collect water, so you don't have to make the journey to a pond or river every day."

9 in every 10 Kenyan kids often experience water shortages and water scarcity.




People in Kenya use an average of about 45 litres of water, per person, per day. That's about 4 buckets and 5 bottles full.

63% of people in Kenya have a safe drinking water supply. 37% do not have safe drinking water.
